Compare the impacts of two recent tax policies.

The Trump Administration's 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (2017 tax law)

- Gave huge tax handouts to the already-wealthy
- Bloated the paychecks of big corporate executives, giving ordinary workers next to nothing
- Worsened the federal deficit by \$7.8 trillion leaving us with less to fund Social Security, health care, and more

The Biden-Harris Administration's 2022 Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)

- Helps ensure the ultra-wealthy pay their fair share
- Required big corporations to finally pay the same tax rate as the average U.S. wage earner
- Funded the IRS to audit wealthy tax cheaters
