Introduction to Project 2025

Project 2025 is an extremist plan for reshaping the United States in profoundly harmful ways. Its agenda includes gutting civil rights protections, bolstering corporations and the ultra-wealthy at the expense of everyone else, and autocratically enlarging the size and power of the federal executive branch.

Project 2025 is published by the Heritage Foundation, a think tank funded by billionaires. The Heritage Foundation offers Project 2025 as **an agenda and playbook for future officeholders** to radically reshape the federal government, with disastrous impacts on almost every facet of life in the United States. The Reagan and Trump administrations adopted many of the policies advanced by the Heritage Foundation in years past.

Project 2025's policies are **designed to privilege a small, white, wealthy ruling class** and their corporate interests, while burdening everyone else. The result would be a society in which millions of us, our families, and our communities would face economic hardship, barriers to democratic participation, a lack of legal protections from discrimination and violence, the weaponization of the legal system to quash political dissent, and **the dismantling of our Constitutional freedoms.**

Because of its presentation as an agenda for future administrations, NETWORK Advocates for Catholic Social Justice reviewed Project 2025 with great interest. Sadly, we must conclude that **Project 2025's policy prescriptions and vision for our country contrast—in deep and disturbing ways—with the teachings and principles of Catholic Social Justice** that have long shaped NETWORK's own advocacy work and policy agenda, as embodied in our **Equally Sacred Checklist**.
